The Montessori Philosophy

Dr. Maria Montessori developed a unique style of education that focuses on how children interact with their world. It is an approach to education with the fundamental belief that a child learns best within a social environment which supports and respects each child's individual development. This "Whole Child" approach is unique in that the primary goal of a Montessori program is to help each child reach full potential in all areas of life: social, emotional, physical and cognitive preparation. The classroom is a prepared environment that allows for self-directed learning to occur with the guidance of a trained Montessori teacher. The Montessori materials are multi-sensory, sequential and self-correcting thereby facilitating independent learning and the learning of abstract ideas.

Educational Programming

Finding the right school for your child is one of the most important family decisions to make. Rock Prairie Montessori School is a non-profit, non-parochial school. It is a school community providing an enriching and challenging educational environment starting at age two and continuing through third grade.
