Toddlers' House Camps

18 months - 3 years

Children ages 18 months up to 3 years old are eligible to attend our Toddlers' House Camps. *Children currently enrolled in our school year Toddlers' House program should enroll in Toddlers' House Summer camp, unless notified by their teacher.* The camps run Monday-Friday 8:30 am to 11:30 am. <u>Campers should bring a snack</u> with them daily. Additional Add-On Care is available from 7:20 am to 4:00 pm.

Each two-week session of our Toddlers' House Camps is filled with educational activities that invite children to explore, create, and learn. Toddlers will enjoy many fun, new works as well as using traditional Montessori materials. Activities and materials are designed to include many curricular areas, including: art, music, practical life (with environmental care), sensorial, language, large motor, imaginative play, and manipulative work. These activities are designed to help develop fine and gross motor skills, concentration, coordination, and independence.

Children's House Camps 3 - 6 years old

Please provide a cold lunch for your camper in addition to their morning snack. You will be invoiced for the programs you choose regardless of attendance.

4:00 pick-up \$30.00/day | Monday-Friday (2024 2nd graders and above not eligible)

Drop-In Care

(48-hour notice is required)

Drop-In Care is available as space permits. Requests need to be made 48 hours in advance of the time needed. **A 48 hours' notice is required for cancellation.**

After Care

1:00 pick-up \$21.00/day (Elementary Camp Students Only)
3:30 pick-up \$36.00/day (2024 2nd graders and above not eligible)
4:00 pick-up \$38.00/day (2024 2nd graders and above not eligible)

How to Register (Online Registration)

Below are the instructions on how to enroll in our summer programming through TADS, our online enrollment server. Summer registration through TADS requires a one-time *family* fee of \$18.00. Registering at least five days before the start of a session is requested. Camps cannot be divided into partial weeks or be prorated. <u>Cancelation</u> <u>Policy</u>: A 14-day notice is required before the start of a session in order to receive a refund.

1. Log into TADS at http://mytads.com/a/rockprairiesummercamp

- Choose "Summer 2024"
- You will be directed to either create an account or log into your school year account
- Once you're logged into your account, you can begin the Admissions process
- 2. Admissions
 - Once you complete the Admissions process RPMS will review your information.
 - Upon acceptance of your application you will receive an email confirming your student has been accepted into the Summer Camps for which you applied, as well as an email asking you to complete the "Tuition Agreement" indicating how you would like to be invoiced and make payments.
 - Camps fill quickly, if there is no space in a requested camp, you will be notified via email and your student will be placed in a waiting pool for entry. The waiting pool is weighted with various criteria for entry. One example is that current families will have more weight than families outside of our school community.
 - Summer programs are designed for student engagement in creative fun. If a camper is unable to participate respectfully with peers or teachers, they will be asked to leave the program. A refund for any unattended days will be given.
